

Interesting twist with the coach and the client co-publishing a book that "opens the doors that normally shield the confidential world of coaching conversations." Several challenging and uncomfortable discussions to enable growth!

Chapter 6: In Session: A Coaching Conversation. Sharing some effective questions:

I wonder if there is an avoidance element with difficult dialogues. What do you think? Is there anything that you notice in your body as we are talking about this? This seems to trigger you. What values of yours might be behind this?

The coach nudged and pushed when required, always fully in the best interest of the client. Together, they defined strengths which "is important to facilitate a leader's awareness, where they excel and where they may have blind spots. Lasting change is only possible when we can embrace our imperfections."
